Chichen Itza, one of the New 7 Wonders of the World, served as the political, economic, and ceremonial center of the Mayan civilization. The famous Mayan pyramids of Chichen Itza are over 1500 years old.

Our certified guides will take you to the massive Kukulcán pyramid, "El Castillo", which is located roughly at the center of the site. Its construction was planned so that during each Vernal Equinox the dying sun would cast a shadow of a serpent (the Mayan God Kukulcan) writhing down the steps of the pyramid.

A vast array of factors and information about the Mayan culture will enlighten you so that you will better understand this unique civilization and feel its presence as you walk the same path of these ancient inhabitants. 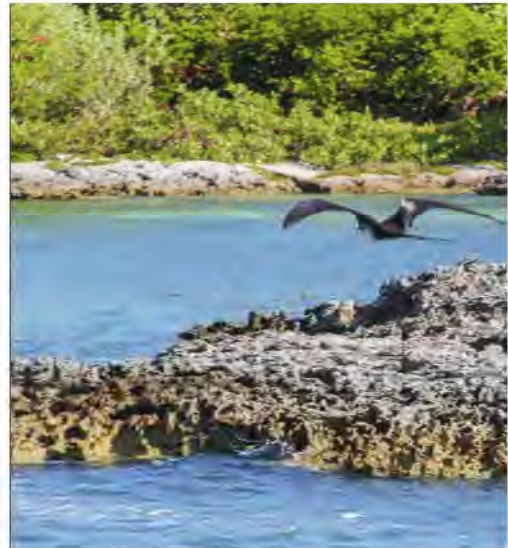
## **Contoy Island**

and a visit to an elementary school, where you will observe a class in session and interact with the children who will be proud to share what they have accomplished. A small gift will be given to one of the children before departing their class.

A short visit with a Mayan family will allow you to relate and learn about their culture and observe how handy crafts are made. You will be welcomed inside the home of a local artisan where he works with barro, a red clay, which is molded into pots and bowls and baked inside of a kiln.

## **The Mayan Ruins of Ek Balam & Valladolid**

Located just north of Valladolid, this is a yet little known site and therefore never overwhelmed with tourists. Ek Balam in the Mayan idiom stands for “Black Jaguar”. When the Mayan abandoned Ek Balam, the site became hidden beneath the dense low-lying jungle.



After our visit of the archeological site, our expedition will continue towards Valladolid, a little Mayan town located half-way between Merida and Cancun.



Valladolid is a small, quaint town that has preserved its special colonial flavors. Mayan women typically sit on the site on one of the plaza where they display and sell their handicrafts, which include hand-embroidered dresses and blouses, place mats and table cloths.

Your encounter with Maya culture starts with a 1,500-year-old historical journey to the ancestral city of Coba, an archeological site hidden deep inside the rain forest of southeastern Yucatan Peninsula. The Mayan ruins of Tulum are the third most-visited historical site in all of Mexico—for a good reason. Tulum enjoys a spectacular cliff-side location, looking out over the majestic Caribbean Sea, which sparkles in vibrant shades of aqua and turquoise. It is, in fact, the only known archaeological site located by the sea.

Tulum was occupied by the Mayan people until the Spanish conquest of the Yucatan Peninsula, but was fully abandoned by the end of the 16th century. Until the late 20th century, local Mayans continued to visit the temples to pray, but today, the restored ruins are used primarily for tourism purposes.
